The Cultural heritage authorities of Norway, having been engaged in projects in this area and cooperating with the central authorities in Bucharest in the EEA financing of cultural heritage projects in Romania find the referred and documented practise of installing electricity meters in these protected / listed villages complete unexplainable.

We are convinced that the company responsible for this work has not conferred and cleared this type of installation with the relevant cultural heritage authorities in Romania or in the region.

We therefore plead that such practice is stopped until proper guidelines for such installations have been approved by the relevant authorities in charge of the Historic Monuments List code BV-II-a-B-11660. We also wish that proper installation guidelines be developed for all interesting historic ensembles in Romania so that they may be not be unnecessarily disfigured instead of preserved for posterity.
